Safeguarding Children:

If you have any concerns that a child has been harmed, is at risk of harm or you receive a disclosure, please contact the main reception as quickly as possible, and ask to speak to the DSL.

Health & Safety:

Your safety and well-being is important to us. As a visitor you have a legal duty of care for the Health & Safety of yourself and others.

Emergency evacuation:

Emergency evacuation procedures are clearly displayed around the building. If the alarm sounds, leave the building by the nearest exit and proceed to the Must Point on the school field.

Accidents:

Any illness, injury or accident must be reported to reception.

Classrooms:

Do not enter classrooms unless escorted by a member of staff or by prior arrangements.

Smoking and alcohol:

It is against the law to smoke, vape or consume alcohol on school premises.

Some of what we do to safeguard children in our school:

- Have a dedicated safeguarding team in place.
- Have a 'cause for concern' reporting system in place.
- Ensure all staff – including outside providers have safeguarding training
- Ensure the school is a secure site.
- Require all staff, parents and visitors to wear identification.
- Take daily attendance registers and follow up absences by calling parents.
- Follow safer recruitment procedures.
- Ensure all staff have police clearance checks.
- Have a school nurse on site.
- Ensure all students have access to the school counsellor.
- Have 31 first aid trained teachers and support staff.
