
We aim to nurture a love of learning building on skills that have been introduced in Early Years (EY). We have a scaffolded curriculum embedding and introducing new concepts yearly.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

The Secondary is split into three key stages.

STAGE	YEAR GROUP	AGE
Key Stage 3	Year 7 - Year 9	11 - 14
Key Stage 4	Year 10 & Year 11	14 - 16

Students are given access to a broad range of subjects to experience different academic disciplines and develop their talents. They will be exposed to a variety of teaching and learning styles and will also be encouraged to think reflectively about their own development. The curriculum offered in Year 10 & 11 builds on the skills, knowledge and understanding gained in Key Stage 3 and more subject choices are introduced to allow greater degree of specialisation. The curriculum at this stage is designed to allow students to keep open as many career paths possible. All students will sit for the IGCSE examinations.




