# Safeguarding 101

**1**

**Protecting children from maltreatment.**

**2**

**Preventing impairment of children's health or development.**

**3**

**Ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care.**

**4**

**Taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.**

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is everyone's responsibility. Everyone who comes into contact with children and their families has a role to play. In order to fulfil this responsibility effectively, all practitioners should make sure their approach is child-centred. This means that they should consider, at all times, what is in the best interests of the child.

# Abuse & Neglect

## NEGLECT

The ongoing failure to meet a Child's most basic needs. Types of neglect can include Emotional, Educational, Medical or Physical.

## PHYSICAL ABUSE

Examples could include slapping, kicking, poisoning, burning, drowning, breaking bones, shaking, throwing, biting or scratching.

## EMOTIONAL ABUSE

Examples could include ignoring, deliberately humiliating, scaring or isolating a child.

## SEXUAL ABUSE

Sexual Abuse can take place online and/or in person and can be through contact and/or non-contact with the child.

## INCREASED VULNERABILITY

Each category of abuse should not be seen in isolation.

# Do's

- ✓ Report any concerns you have to a member of the safeguarding team
- ✓ Listen to students when they talk to you
- ✓ Remain calm and understanding
- ✓ If a child shares something with you, write down exactly what was reported

# Dont's

- ✗ Do not befriend students on social media sites
- ✗ Do not discuss school or parents on social networking sites
- ✗ Do not take or post pictures of students or the school on social media sites
- ✗ Do not touch students
- ✗ Do not enter student changing rooms or toilets
- ✗ Do not promise to keep information shared with you a secret
- ✗ Never blame a child for something that has happened to them
- ✗ Do not share confidential information with third parties
- ✗ Do not communicate with students or parents via WhatsApp
