Subjects

Your learning journey will be exciting at Tenby SEH. You will be getting better in maths, English, Mandarin, and Bahasa Melayu, and exploring lots of different subjects like science, art, D&T, history, geography, and music through our project-based learning topics.

Our project-based learning includes really great topics like Hola Mexico! Stargazers, Blood Heart, Burps, Bottoms, Bile & Ears! and Land Ahoy!

The topics are hands-on and include lots of research and investigation. They are creative, engaging, and enjoyable – full of good struggles.

We have PSHE and computing too, and not forgetting PE and swimming every week. It really is an Amazing Learning opportunity.

Facilities

We have wonderful facilities in Tenby SEH. As well as our classrooms, we have a STEAM room in the Primary Block, where KS1 and Year 3 learn art, D&T and science, and another art and D&T room for KS2 near the KS2 Block.

There is a well-equipped music room in the Primary Block, and there are two IT suites. There are also two great libraries, to read in, listen to stories in, borrow books from or study in. We also have a wonderful cookery room, a green screen room, and a drama room that we share with the secondary school.

Sport

We play lots of different sports in Tenby SEH. We love to play basketball, badminton, and football. There are lots of school teams too, like bench ball, football, and cross-country.

Our sports complex, The Colosseum, is home to our sports teams, the Tenby Gladiators, and is a wonderful place to practise your skills. We also have two great pools where the children learn to swim and can take part in our Tenby Swim Gala.



What CCAs can I join?

We have lots of fantastic CCAs at Tenby SEH. They are held from 3pm to 4pm and are a great way to make new friends and experience different kinds of learning. We have CCAs every day of the week and you can choose to take part in as many or as few as you wish.

We understand you might be worried about moving up, but it will also be exciting. You will still be with your friends, and you will make new friends as well.




Whichever class you move to, in whichever year, you will still have the same wonderful welcome you received when you started at Tenby Setia EcoHill.
